- 2. Complete an application and include all required information (most recent transcript or report card, current attendance records, CAASPP test scores, and IEP if applicable).
- If you have an IEP, the amendment must specify that independent study is recommended.
- It is highly recommended students have a 2.0 GPA or above at their current school.
- 5. Intake interviews are conducted twice a month from August through April 3, 2020.
